What to expect at your first visit

During your first visit, your doctor will listen to your problems and ask you a number of questions.

He/she will likely examine you and review any X-rays or other test results that you have.

Your doctor will give you his/her opinion and recommendations. You may be sent for further tests and be asked to return for follow-up. Based on the results of your test(s) a diagnosis will be made and the appropriate treatment will be explained and offered to you. Please feel free to ask as many questions as you like.

When you come for your first visit, please remember to obtain and bring the following:

- Referral letter from GP, family physician or other doctor
- Medicare card, DVA card, pension card
- Have your private hospital insurance information with you
- Latest blood reports, X-rays, MRIs, CT scans and any other relevant information

Urgent Appointments

Urgent Appointments are booked on the day and are for patients who have problems which, for medical reasons, cannot wait for a routine appointment.

Telehealth Appointments

We provide telehealth consultations via the phone and video. Please speak to our reception team to organise a telehealth consultation.

Cancellation of Appointment

If you need to cancel your appointment, we require 24 hours' notice. This enables us to offer your selected appointment time to another patient.

Payment of Consultation Fee

Our payment policy for our doctor consultation fee is to be made via eftpos/credit card payments. We do not accept cash payments. We require payment at time of consultation. When making your first initial appointment, our reception team will advise you of the consultation fee payable at the time of consultation.
